

## **Short Oral Presentation Guidelines:**

Prioritize effective presentation preparation with three key steps: planning, practicing, and presenting. Address these areas:

**Introduction**: Cover topic relevance, a brief outline of the presentation's significant points, and a brief greeting/introduction.

**Main Body**: Provide clear explanations, evidence, transitions, and built-in repetition of ideas. **Conclusion**: Signal the conclusion, summarize points, and end appropriately (e.g., "Thank You"). Include variety and transition to Q&A.
